The Gospel reading of today (Luke 22:14 - 23:25) reflects on the Last Supper, Trials and Crucifixion of Christ. During the Last Supper, Jesus told his disciples that "He had eagerly desired to eat this Passover with them before his suffering". It was their last meal together and was sealed with a request

"Do this in memory of me". The Bread of Life they heard in the gospel Of John Chapter 6, was now made present for their spiritual nourishment.

At the Garden of Gethsemane, the faith of the Apostles was put to the test after the arrest of Jesus, and they were found wanting. The trials that followed made it much worse. At his Crucifixion, it was still not over. Christ continued to preach from the cross, granting pardon to those crucified with him and making excuses for those that Crucified him. The "highs" of the Triumphant Entry with Palms, had been silenced by the gruesome Crucifixion. Jesus our Passover Victim has given his life to redeem and sanctify us. We adore you oh Christ and we praise thee, because by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the World. Amen.


